#### HHHS Meeting September 22,2023

#### Committee reports:

Finance: No report

<u>Buildings and Grounds:</u> John Woolley reported that work on the MacKenzie House was completed. New shutters were put up as of today. He stressed the need for constant care of the building. He asked that we try to use the contractors who were involved at MacKenzie, if needed. He is hoping to begin programs at MacKenzie once the inside is organized. A sign-up sheet is available tonight for the needed inside work.

Jude Meehan stated that decisions need to be made as to what to keep or not at MacKenzie. He felt we should only display items and furnishings that are period appropriate. Decisions need to be made as to the plans for each room in the house. It needs to be decided where the library will be placed. There needs to be criteria for donations.

There was debate as to who should have access to both buildings.

Laurie Smith would like to return to MacKenzie to further evaluate the clothing. She has purchased some items of clothing so far.

#### **New Business:**

It was decided that designated action committees were needed to facilitate and quicken the movement of needed work and decisions. Virginia Woolley proposed that we have an Open House at MacKenzie on October 14 from 2:30- 5:00 for members and to possibly invite the Howell Council members.
